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**Order No. 17/2018**

Director of the M. Mossakowski Medical Institute, Polish Academy of Sciences dated September 14, 2018.

Pursuant to: Regulation of the Minister of Labor and Social Policy of December 1, 1998 (Journal of Laws of 1998, No. 148. item 973) *on safety and hygiene of work at workplaces equipped with screen monitors*; Article 9 (3) of the Council Directive of May 29, 1990 *on the minimum safety and health requirements for work with equipment equipped with screen monitors (fifth individual directive within the meaning of Article 16 (1) of Directive 87/391/EEC)(90/270/EEC)*,  
at workstations equipped with screen monitors I order as follows:

1. An employee of the Institute using a screen monitor at work for at least half of the daily working hours shall be entitled to eye-correcting glasses or contact lenses, as prescribed by a doctor, if the results of an eye examination conducted as part of preventive health care show the need for their use while working at a screen monitor.
2. On the basis of a VAT invoice presented by an Employee of the Institute, issued to the Institute, including the name of the Employee and information about the purpose of glasses or contact lenses – for work at a screen monitor on the above-mentioned invoice, the expenses for the purchase of corrective glasses and frames for glasses or contact lenses recommended by a doctor are partially reimbursed.
3. The amount of reimbursement referred to in point 2 is determined by the Director of IMDiK PAN and communicated to employees. It is granted no more often than once every 3 years.
4. The Order shall come into effect as of the date of signature.
5. At the same time, Order No. 8/2012 dated September 05, 2012 is repealed.
